So the second resolution was rejected.

The third resolution was then read the second time;

On motion of Mr. Keene, the third resolution was amended by striking out "one hundred," and inserting "fifty;"

The question was then put, will the house assent to the third resolution;

Determined in the negative.

The question then recurred upon the adoption of the substitute for the resolution, substitute, and amendment;

Resolved in the affirmative.

The said resolution was then read the second time and assented to.

The Clerk of the Senate returned the bill, entitled, an act to grant a donation to the Manchester Academy, in Carroll county;

Also, the bill, entitled, a further additional supplement to the act, entitled, an act for the founding an Academy at Hagerstown, in Washington county;

Also the bill, entitled, an act relating to the free school fund heretofore received by Frederick and Baltimore counties, and now owned and held by the said counties, severally endorsed, "will pass," and the bills severally ordered to be engrossed;

Also, the bill, entitled, an act to limit the time of continuing in office the Inspectors and Lottery Commissioners of this State, endorsed, "will not pass;"

Also, the bill, entitled, an act providing for the appointment of clerks of the several county courts, the clerks of the court of Appeals for the Eastern and Western Shores, the clerk of Baltimore city court, and the Registers of Wills in the several counties of this State, endorsed, "amendment of the house to the amendment of the senate disagreed to."

Mr. Buchanan then moved that the house recede from their amendment;"

Resolved in the affirmative.

The amendments of the senate were then assented to, and the bill ordered to be engrossed.

Also, the resolution in favor of the securities of Marcy Fountain, endorsed, "dissented from;"

And, delivered the following bills, originated in and passed by the senate, viz:
