

State and the Corporations, or persons who shall make such proposed loan, to postpone said existing liens, they cannot concur in the passage of any bill which shall, in any other respect, or to any greater extent, lessen, postpone, or impair, in any degree, the liens and securities now held by the State. A provision annexed to said bill, requiring the assent of all the parties interested, would, it is supposed, prevent any such result.

Which was read, and with the bill therein mentioned, referred to the committee on internal improvement.

Mr. Jump, submitted the following resolution.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Treasurer of the Western Shore be, and he is hereby directed to pay to the Reverend Mr. Poisal, Chaplain to this house, and the Reverend Mr. McIlhenny, Chaplain to the Senate, each the sum of one hundred dollars, as a remuneration for performing divine service during the present session of the legislature.

Which was read the first and by special order the second time, and assented to.

Mr. Tuck, chairman of the committee on coloured-population, made a favourable report upon the bill from the Senate, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act to authorise the recording of a certain deed of sale and manumission, passed December session 1834, chap. 282;

Which was read.

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.

Mr. Bowler, reported a bill, entitled, an act to lay out and open a public road in Frederick and Carroll counties;

Which was read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Brengle, chairman of the select committee, made an unfavourable report upon the bill from the senate, entitled, an act to change the divisional line between Frederick county and Carroll county, and between Baltimore county and Carroll county, as therein mentioned, and to alter the constitution and form of government so far as may be necessary to effect the same.

Which was read the first and second time by special order and concurred in.

The said bill was then read the second time and rejected.

The house took up for consideration the report and resolution submitted by him on 3d instant, from the joint com-
