And, the bill, entitled, an act to change the divisional line, between Frederick county and Carroll county, and between Baltimore county and Carroll county, as therein mentioned, and to alter the constitution and form of government so far as may be necessary to effect the same;

Were returned to the senate.

Mr. Shower presented a petition of sundry citizens of the 6th, 9th, and 13th election districts in Baltimore county, praying the erection of an additional district in said county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Shower, Worthington and Risteau.

And, Mr. Ely presented a petition of sundry citizens the first election district in Baltimore county, praying that the place of holding the election in said district may be changed from the place where they are now held, to Daniel Linchberger's Tavern on the Frederick turnpike road;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Ely, Worthington and Risteau.

Mr. Harding obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, an act relating to the third and fifth congressional districts of this State;

Ordered, that Messrs. Harding, Brengle and Dawson, report the same.

Mr. Palmer, from the select committee, made an unfavorable report upon the petition of sundry citizens of Queen Anne's county, praying the passage of an act for the purpose therein mentioned;

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and concurred in.

Mr. Palmer, also from the select committee, to whom was referred the petition of several citizens of Primary School districts No. 22, and 23, of Queen Anne's county, praying the passage of a law authorising the said districts to be united, and the same to be incorporated in a school, to be called the Ruthsburg Union School, and the petition of other citizens of said county, counter thereto, reported, that owing to the conflicting statements made in the two petitions, the committee are induced to report unfavorably on the subject;

Which was read the first, and by special order the second time, and concurred in.
