

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, chairman of the committee on ways and means, entitled, a supplement to the act to incorporate the Farmers' and Millers' Bank of Hagerstown, was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Alexander,

Said bill was amended as follows,

After the word Hagerstown, in the 3d line of 1st section, strike out the word 'incorporated' and insert the word 'established,' and after the word 'the' in the same line, insert the word 'entitled' before the word 'act.'

In the 8th line of 1st section, strike out the word twenty and insert the word ten.

In the 4th line of 3rd section after the word nine, insert the words 'and that as soon as ten thousand shares of the said capital stock of said Bank shall be subscribed, the subscribers thereof shall be, and hereby are made a corporation and body politic, under the same name and style, and with the same rights, powers and privileges, and subject to the same conditions and restrictions as are granted or imposed by the original act to which this is a supplement, and not inconsistent herewith.'

On motion of Mr. Alexander,

Said bill was further amended by adding at the end of third section, the following,

'And that every subscriber shall pay at the time of subscription, to the said commissioners, the sum of two dollars and fifty cents on each share that shall be by him or her subscribed, and each subscriber shall within sixty days thereafter, pay to said commissioners the further sum of two dollars and fifty cents on each share, and the remaining five dollars on each share shall be paid by such instalments, and at such times as the Directors shall appoint according to the provisions of the 6th section of the act to which this is a supplement.'

The said bill was then read the second time as amended passed and sent to the Senate.

On motion of Mr. Crisfield, the house took up for consideration the resolutions submitted by him on the 17th instant, in relation to the digest of the laws;

The said resolutions were then read the second time, and on the question being put, will the house assent to said resolutions?

It was determined in the negative.
