And, the resolution in relation to publishing certain laws, severally endorsed 'assented to,' and severally ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Gough, chairman of the committee on engrossed

bills, delivered the following report,

The committee on engrossed bills, beg leave to report, that they have carefully examined and compared the engrossed bills of the House of Delegates, from No ninety, to No. two hundred and forty-nine, inclusive, and from No. two hundred and eighty six, to No. three hundred and ten, inclusive; also the engrossed bills of the Senate, from No. two hundred and fifty, to No. two hundred and eighty five, inclusive, and No. three hundred and eleven; also the engrossed resolutions from No. one to No sixty-one, inclusive, with the originals thereof, as heretofore passed by both branches of the Legislature, since the commencement of the present session, and that they have found the same truly engrossed.
