

Which was read, and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject;

Mr. Bruce, presented a petition of sundry citizens of Allegany county, praying for the passage of an act incorporating a Bank to be called the Union Bank of Allegany;

Which was read and referred to the committee on ways and means.

Mr. Kershner, presented the pay roll of the Williamsport Rifle company, commanded by captain Isaac Allen, of Washington county, praying to be compensated for services rendered in the Canal riots in 1834;

Which was read and referred to the committee on claims.

Mr. Worthington, presented a petition of sundry citizens of Frederick county, protesting against the formation of "Carroll county," out of Baltimore and Frederick counties;

Which was read and referred to the committee already appointed on that subject.

Mr. McLean, presented a memorial of the board of trade of Baltimore, praying an appropriation for another ice boat to keep open the harbour of Baltimore, during the winter season;

Which was read and referred to the committee on internal improvement.

And, Mr. Iglehart, presented a petition of sundry citizens of the fourth election district in Anne Arundel county, praying an alteration in said district;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Iglehart, Ridgely and Simmons.

Mr. Eccleston asked to be excused from serving on the committee on colored population;

On the question being put, it was

Determined in the affirmative.

The Speaker thereupon appointed Mr. Handy on said committee in the place of Mr. Eccleston, who was excused by the house.

Mr. Richardson obtained leave to bring in a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act entitled, an act to authorise William Krebs, Richard Linthicum, and William Linthicum to build a bridge over Gwynn's Falls, passed at December session 1835, chapter 24.

Ordered, That Messrs. Richardson, Ely and Iglehart report the same.

Mr. Hicks obtained leave to bring in a bill to be entitled, an act supplemental to an act passed November session 1798, chapter 82, appointing commissioners to contract for
