

Coloured Population; petition of Biner Cook, a free woman of color, for authority to remain in this State, 240; bill reported, 304-5; passed, 470; sent to the senate, 472; returned rejected, 571.

Enquiry as to withholding entirely from free negroes, licenses as traders and keepers of ordinaries, or if not entirely, then of requiring additional security of, 241.

Enquiry as to the expediency of excluding free negroes, and mulattoes, from acquiring or holding real estate in this State, and if &c.—to report a bill allowing not over two years for that portion of our population, to alienate real estate, now in their possession, proposed, 243; motion to amend the order, proceedings on, *ib.*

Resolution requiring the clerk of St. Mary's county court, to repay a sum paid by Mrs. Emely Forrest, for introducing certain slaves into this State, proposed, 253; proceedings on—resolution adopted, *ib.*; sent to the senate, 256.

Petition of John R. Hamm, of Delaware, to be permitted to bring certain manumitted slaves into this State, 311; bill reported, 616; referred to the next General Assembly, 717.
