The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following message:

BY THE HOUSE OF DELEGATES,
February 18, 1864.

Gentlemen of the Senate:

We propose, with the concurrence of your Honorable Body, the appointment of a joint special committee of five, whose duty it shall be to enquire into the expediency of the adoption of a General Law, whereby the banks of this State incorporated under the State laws, shall have the privilege and power, at their discretion to change their present organization and re-organize under the provisions of the "National Banking Act."

Said committee to report by bill or otherwise.

We have appointed Messrs. Chappell, Lester and Westcott on the part of this House.
