A bill to refund to J. C. White a sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury;

A bill for the relief of T. J. Hardesty and J. G. Gover, of Anne Arundel county;

A bill to continuance in force the Act of 1862, chapter 276, for the relief of families of Maryland volunteers;

A bill to refund a sum of money erroneously paid into the Treasury by Henry Gantz;

A bill to release the claim of the State to the balances of direct tax with which J. M. Carleton stands charged;

A bill to authorize the issuing of new bonds in substitution of bonds heretofore authorized to be issued by the Tide Water and Susquehanna Canal Companies.

Also, reported with an amendment, which was read and adopted, the bill to refund to Julia Gittings, administratrix of T. E. Gittings, deceased, taxes erroneously paid into the Treasury;

Also, reported without amendment, a bill entitled, "An Act to refund to S. R. Gore money erroneously paid into the Treasury;"
