

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend the charter of the President, Managers and Company of the Baltimore and Yorktown Turnpike road, being an additional supplement to An Act entitled, 'An Act to incorporate companies to make several turnpike roads through Baltimore county, and for other purposes,' passed at November session, 1804, chapter 51;"

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.

A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize the county commissioners of Baltimore county to borrow money and pay bounties to volunteers;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Finance.

A bill entitled, "An Act to amend section 494 of article 4 of the Code of Public Local Laws entitled, 'City of Baltimore,' relating to the measurement of oysters;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on the Chesapeake Bay and its Tributaries.

A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize and empower Levin L. Keene of Dorchester county, to build a dam across Keene's ditch or creek, between Lake's and Hooper's Island districts in said county, and to erect a tide mill thereat;"

Read the first time and referred to Messrs. Carroll, Tome and Bayless.

A bill entitled, "An Act to extend the time for the organization and election of managers of the Buckeystown Turnpike Road Company, and to continue the Act of 1860, chapter 323, in force;"

Read the first time and referred to the committee on Internal Improvements.

A bill entitled, "An Act to authorize Henry Cannon Charles of Caroline county, who is under twenty-one years of age, to receive from and release Joshua Noble and Charles Wright, administrator of his father, Charles Cannon, the distributive share due to him from the estate of his said father, and also contract for and purchase a farm and carry on the same as fully as if he were of full age;"

Read the first time, and referred to the committee on Judicial Proceedings.

A bill entitled, "An Act to refund to Ambrose A. White, and Francis W. Elder, partners trading in the city of Baltimore under the name of White & Elder, and George R.
