Strike out in the 4th section and 4th line of the printed bill after the word "oath" down to the word "whatever", and insert "I—do swear or affirm as the case may be, that I will support the Constitution of the United States, and that I will be faithful and bear true allegiance to the State of Maryland and support the Constitution and laws thereof, and that I will to the best of my skill and judgment diligently and faithfully without partiality or prejudice, execute the duties of delegate to the Convention to reform the Constitution of this State, and that since the adoption of the present Constitution, I have not in any manner violated the provision thereof in relation to bribing of voters or procuring legal or illegal votes to be given, and that I will not directly or indirectly receive the profits or any part of the profits of any other office during the time of my acting as delegate to said Convention ;"

Which was read.
