

So the Senate adopted the substitute.

The Clerk of the House of Delegates delivered the following bill :

A bill entitled, An act requiring the Orphans' Court of Prince George's county to pay the Trustees of the Bladensburg Academy, who are now in the possession of the said academy, and who were elected under the provisions of the original charter of the trustees of said academy, any money now in the hands of the said Court, payable by law to the said academy ;

Which was read the first time, and referred to Messrs. Lynch, Smith, and Goldsborough, of Dorchester.

The Senate adjourned.
