Leave was granted Messrs. Nuttle, Townsend, and Goldsborough, of Dorchester, to report a bill for an additional justice of the peace in the second election district of Caroline county.

On motion of Mr. McKaig,

Leave was granted the Committee on Judicial Proceedings, to report a bill entitled, An act to amend the 16th Article of the Code of Public General Laws, by adding thereto the following section, relating to the powers of Courts of Chancery in selling lands.

On motion of Mr. Miles,

Leave was granted Messrs. Miles, Nuttle and Gardiner, to report a bill to incorporate the Sonora and Arizona Company.

Mr. Lynch, from the Committee on Corporations, reported the following bills :
