

A Form where a New Article is to be added to the Code.

A BILL entitled, An Act to add a new Article to the Code of Public General Laws for (whatever may be the subject) :

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following Article be added to the Code of Public General Laws :

SECTION 1.

SECTION 2, and so on.

A Form where an Article is to be Amended by adding New Sections.

A BILL entitled, An Act to add the following Sections, relating to (here describe the subject of the sections) Article —, of the Code of Public General Laws :

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, (here state the subject under section, numbering them 1, 2, &c).

A Form where a Section or Sections is or are to be Amended, relating to the same subject.

A BILL entitled, An Act to amend the 5th and 6th sections relating to (here describe the subject), of Article ten of the Code of Public General Laws.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the 5th and 6th sections of Article ten, of the Code of Public General Laws, (relating to, &c.,) be and the same are hereby repealed, and the following enacted as a substitute therefor.

Sometimes it may be designed to repeal a section of a Public Local Law, and make it a General Law ; when this is the case, the Public Local Law on that subject must be repealed.

If the sections embrace more than one subject, they must be in separate bills.
