ANNUAL REPORT, December 30, 1899

To the Honorable

The Senators of Maryland

In obedience to the Act of 1898, chapter 666, I have the honor to report to the Legislature of Maryland, that since the 10th of March, 1898, drafts have been drawn upon the Civil Bureau, Washington, in amount of \$1,000,000.00, for the purpose of raising the State of Maryland, by the United States, as per appointment, authorized by the Act of Congress, 1898, in favor of Volunteer Companies, etc., as per copy of account with Ordnance Department marked A, together with accompanying statement of funds received thereon, marked B, and on file in this office.

Statement C is a report of the State Attorney at Baltimore, Md., made to this Department of all the State Appointments, etc., made in the Army at Baltimore, Md.

Statement D is a report made by the State Attorney at Frederick, to the Department of the Army, etc., in the Army at Frederick.

Statement E is a report of the Army, etc., in the Army at Annapolis, Md.

It is impossible for the office here to show the number of arms belonging to the State, which, from an early date, have been issued in favor of Volunteer and other Militia Companies.
