

On motion of Mr. Greene,

Leave was granted the committee on Corporations to introduce a bill to incorporate the Locust Point Wharf Company.

On motion of Mr. Lester,

Leave was granted the committee on Ways and Means to introduce a bill to alter and change the mode of payment of the Crier of the Court of Appeals.

On motion of Mr. Hebb,

Leave was granted the committee on the Judiciary to introduce a bill entitled, "An Act to release William Price, Thomas J. McKaig, George W. Brown and George A. Pearre; and also to release the Cumberland Coal and Iron Company, from the claim for taxes preferred in the State's bill in equity, filed in the Circuit Court for Allegany county, as a court of equity, on the 2d day of December, in the year 1854, and requiring said bill to be dismissed.

On motion of Mr. Pierce, of Queen Anne's,

Leave was granted the Queen Anne's county delegation to report a bill to repeal sections 157 and 158 of Public Local Laws for Queen Anne's county, and re-enact the same with amendments.

Leave was granted the Baltimore city delegation to introduce a bill to provide for paying the cost and expenses of grading North Avenue from Pennsylvania Avenue to the Northern Central Railway in the city of Baltimore, by the Mayor and City Council of said city.
