

strike out all after the word "any" in 19th line of section 4, to the end of the section, and insert the following: "Senator or Delegate may be eligible to a seat in said Convention, but that no Senator or Representative in the Congress of the United States, or Judge of any Circuit Court, Superior Court, Court of Common Pleas or Criminal Court of the city of Baltimore, Clerks of said Courts, Register of Wills, or Sheriff, shall be eligible to said Convention."

The Senate to agree to amendment of the House of Delegates at end of section 3d, adding the following words, "provided it shall be the duty of the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and of the President of the Senate, to provide a reporter of the debates and proceedings of said Convention, who shall act until the said Convention shall provide its own officers."

The Senate also to agree to amend 4th and 5th lines of section 8th, by striking out the words, "by the Judges of election;"
