Which was read the first time.

Mr. Hoffman, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill, entitled, "An Act to repeal An Act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed March 9th, 1860, chapter 215, entitled, 'An Act to amend the third article of the Code of Public Local Laws, by adding thereto certain sections, vesting the county commissioners of Baltimore county with power to lay out a certain road from Catonsville to the Rolling road,' and to substitute the following sections in lieu thereof;"

Which was read the first time.

Mr. Stockbridge, from a select committee, reported favorably Senate bill entitled, "An Act to add the following sections to article four of Public Local Law, subject 'Police of Baltimore City,' in relation to the trial and discharge of persons arrested by the police."

Mr. McNeal, from a select committee, reported favorably Senate bill entitled, "An Act to change and alter school districts No. 20 and 21, in Caroline county, so as to attach the following described district to the Opossum Hill School District, and electing Trustees for the same;"

Mr. Sykes, from a select committee, reported favorably a bill entitled, "An Act to amend article thirteen of the Code of Public Local Laws, entitled "Howard county" by adding thereto a new section relating to free scholarships in Schools, Academies and Colleges;"
