A bill entitled, "An Act to allow Thomas J. Hutchens late Sheriff of Calvert county, further time to complete his collections;"

Endorsed, "passed by yeas and nays, with proposed amendment."

AMENDMENT PROPOSED:

Amend section 1, by adding thereto the following:

"*Provided*, That it shall be the duty of the said Thomas J. Hutchens, before he proceeds to execute the property of any person or persons for fees or claims, in virtue of this act, to deliver to such person or persons, chargeable with the same, at least thirty days previous to the levying of such execution, a fair account, in writing, of the fees or claims demanded of him, her or them, and an affidavit thereto annexed, that he hath not, directly or indirectly, received any part thereof, or any security or satisfaction for the same, more than the credits given, to the best of his knowledge."

The amendment was concurred in, and the bill, as amended, passed by yeas and nays as follow:
