The bill entitled, "An Act to compensate Frank H. Stockett, of Anne Arundel county, for the value of a negro slave;"

The bill entitled, "An Act to authorize and empower the county commissioners for Carroll county, in their discretion to borrow money to pay volunteers and drafted men, and to issue county certificates therefor, and to levy on the taxable property of Carroll county for their payment;"

Was read the second time, and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.

The bill entitled, "An Act to refund to Samuel T. Stone-street, late clerk of the County court of Montgomery county, a sum of money erroneously paid by him into the Treasury;"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading;

The bill entitled, "An Act to allow Seth W. Warfield, former sheriff and collector of taxes for Howard county, further time to complete his collections;"

Was read the second time and ordered to be engrossed for a third reading.
