The said bill was then returned to the Senate.

The Secretary of the Senate delivered the following Senate bill:

A bill entitled, "An Act supplemental to an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, entitled, 'an act to authorize the persons therein named to build a Methodist meeting house on the public grounds in Chestertown, Kent county, passed at November session of 1801;'"

Which was read the first time and referred to Messrs. Cosden, Westcott and Starr.

## AMENDMENT PROPOSED.

Strike out all after the enacting clause and insert:

"No person within this State shall sell, dispose of, or barter any spirituous or fermented liquors or cordials of any kind, in any quantity whatever, on the Sabbath Day, commonly called Sunday; and any person violating the provision of
