

this section shall be liable to indictment in any court of this State having criminal jurisdiction, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than twenty dollars nor more than one hundred dollars, at the discretion of the court, for the first offence, or, in the discretion of the court, may be imprisoned in jail not more than thirty days; and if convicted a second time for a like offence, shall be fined not less than fifty dollars nor more than two hundred dollars, at the discretion of the court, or, at the discretion of the court, may be sentenced to jail for not more than sixty days; and it shall not be necessary to allege in any indictment that the offence charged is a second offence; and the license of the person so offending shall be adjudged void by the judge of said court."

The amendment was concurred, and the bill, as amended, passed by yeas and nays as follow :
