Which was read,—and

On motion of Mr. Mann,

Referred to the committee on grievances and courts of justice.

Mr. McDaniel, chairman of the select committee, reported a bill, entitled, an act to incorporate the Union Silk Company of Kent county,

Which was read,—and

On motion of Mr. McDaniel,

Referred to the committee on corporations.

The bill reported by Mr. Simmons, from the committee on inspections, entitled, a supplement to an act to establish State Warehouses in the city of Baltimore,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Patran,

Said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Alexander, entitled, an act to amend and reduce into one the act to incorporate the American Life Insurance and Trust Company, and the several supplements thereto,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Alexander,

Said bill was amended by striking out in the 4th section, these words, "and the same sum on every hundred dollars of any future increase of such capital;"

On motion of Mr. Alexander,

Said bill was further amended by inserting after the word "Cancellor," in the 11th section, 4th line, the words, "or Baltimore county court sitting as a court of equity;"

On motion of Mr. Alexander,

Said bill was further amended by adding at the end thereof, as an additional section, the following:

"Sec. 17. And be it enacted, That upon the acceptance of this act as provided for by the preceding section in the act, entitled, an act to incorporate the American Life Insurance and Trust Company, and several supplements thereto, shall be, and they are hereby considered as repealed."

The said bill was then read the second time as amended, and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. McDaniel, from the committee on corporations, entitled, an act to incorporate the Order of United Brothers of Baltimore,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Simmons, entitled, an act to establish and confirm certain acts done by Thomas Allein, a justice of the peace in Anne Arundel county,

Was taken up for consideration, read the second time and passed.
