Which were severally read the first time and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Huddleson reported a bill, entitled, an act for the promotion of education in Allegany county, by means of the poor school fund of said county;

Which was read and referred to the committee on education.

Mr. Giles reported a bill, entitled, a supplement to an act, entitled, an act relating to the city of Baltimore, passed at December session, 1837;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, passed, and sent to the senate.

Mr. Blocher reported a bill, entitled, an act to alter and change the division line between the fourth and fifth election districts of Allegany county;

Which was read the first, and by a special order the second time, and passed.

The hour having arrived for taking up the orders of the day,

The house proceeded to consider the bill reported by Mr. Brown, entitled, an act for the establishment of a Civil Municipal Jurisdiction over a part of Anne Arundel county, and to alter and change the constitution of this State, so far as may be necessary to effect the same;

On motion of Mr. Brown, said bill was postponed until the 16th instant;

The bill reported by Mr. Risteau, chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce Rachel Harding, of the city of Baltimore, from her husband John H. Harding, was taken up for consideration;

Mr. Berret moved that said bill be laid on the table;

Determined in the negative.

The said bill was then read the second time and passed.
