Mr. Biser presented a petition of John Jacobs, of Frederick county, praying to be divorced from his wife Christiana Jacobs;

Which was read and referred to the committee on divorces.

Mr. Sprigg presented a petition of Gracy Perry, a colored woman, praying the passage of an act allowing her to remove into this State;

Which was read and referred to the committee on colored population.

Mr. Harrison presented a petition of James Merrick and others, citizens of Queen Anne's county, praying the passage of a law authorising the opening of a continuous ditch, down the South East Branch in said county, under the direction of commissioners;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Harrison, Grason, Roberts and Wilmer.

Mr. Harrison also presented a petition of Stephen I. Bradley and others, citizens of Queen Anne's county, praying a repeal of so much of the primary school law as inhibits the admission of children into said schools above the age of fifteen years, so far as relates to district No. 15, in said county;

Which was read and referred to Messrs. Harrison, Grason, Roberts and Wilmer.

Mr. Powder presented a petition of sundry citizens of Manchester, praying the passage of a law to incorporate the Military Band of Instrumental Music, in Carroll county,
