Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sums of money hereinafter mentioned, be and the same are hereby appropriated for the purposes following: that is to say, the sum of _____ for repairing, painting and furnishing the Senate Chamber; the sum of _____ for repairing, painting and furnishing the Executive Chamber; the sum of _____ for repairing, white-washing and furnishing the State Library; the sum of _____ for repairing, white-washing and painting the Centre Hall; the sum of _____ for repairing and painting the exterior of the State House; the sum of _____ for preparing a suitable place under the State House to stow the wood and coal for the use of the public offices; the sum of _____ for grading, paving and improving the grounds within the public circle, and also lamps, and an additional pump; to be placed in the same.

Resolved, that the repairs and improvements hereby authorised to be made under the direction of some suitable person or persons to be appointed by the Governor, and the said person or persons are hereby strictly prohibited, in making contracts for the same, for exceeding the appropriations hereby made for the same purposes respectively; and the said sums of money hereby appropriated, or so much thereof as shall be necessary for the aforesaid purposes, shall be paid on the order of the Governor, out of any monies in the treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Resolved by the General Assembly of Maryland, that the Governor be and hereby is authorised and required to cause a suitable fire apparatus to be purchased for the use and protection of the public property at the seat of government, and to draw on the treasurer for the amount thereof, not exceeding _____
