

On motion of Mr. Blocher, said bill was further amended by adding at the end thereof as an additional section, the following,

And be it enacted, that nothing herein contained shall be so construed as to confer the privilege on said society, of issuing any note, certificate or check of any kind or description whatever, for circulation.

The said bill was then read the second time as amended and passed.

The bill reported by Mr. Risteau, chairman of the committee on divorces, entitled, an act to divorce William Start, of Queen Anne's county, from his wife Catharine Start,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Wilmer, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Powell, entitled, an act to alter the mode of appointing the overseers of the poor of Worcester county, in this State,

Was taken up for consideration;

On motion of Mr. Townsend, said bill was ordered to lie on the table.

The bill reported by Mr. Comegys, entitled, an act for the better preservation of the estates of minors in the hands of their guardians, and the favorable report of the committee on grievances and courts of justice, on said bill,
