SATURDAY, March, 17th, 1838.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday.

On motion of Mr. Duke, the rule of the house which requires the journal of proceedings of the preceding day to be read, was suspended, and the reading of said journal was dispensed with.

The bill, entitled, an act to amend the constitution and form of government of the State of Maryland;

The bill from the senate, entitled, an act to authorise John Lam-mott, former collector in the third collection district in Baltimore county, to complete his collections—rejected by this house on yesterday;

Was returned to the senate.

Mr. Iglehart presented a petition of sundry citizens of Anne Arundel county, praying that provision may be made for the erection of Scales in the city of Baltimore, for the weight of hay and straw;

Which was read and referred to the committee on inspections.

Mr. Biser presented a petition signed by sixty citizens of Petersville district in Frederick county, praying the legislature to reject the application of sundry citizens of said county who petitioned for a new county, to be called Lee county;
