Ordered that the committee on, enquire into the expediency of fixing certain disabilities upon the people of color of this State, in relation to holding of property and other matters, as will tend to the encouragement of the colonization of that people, 23.

Ordered that the committee on, enquire as to the expediency of imposing by law, such restrictions on the free negroes of this State, as will encourage their emigration, by preventing them from pursuing for a livelihood any business, mechanic art or trade, &c., 25.

Petition of citizens of Allegany county, for a law to authorise the citizens of said county, to hire slaves from Virginia, without requiring any record or other formality, &c., 27.

Enquiry ordered as to the expediency of abolishing the restrictions upon the removal of slaves into this State by their owners, citizens of, or non-resident landholders therein, &c. 32.
