

The engrossed bills of the Senate from No. 321 to No. 356 inclusive, were read and assented to, and sent to the house of delegates.

The clerk of the house of delegates returned said bills, endorsed "read and assented to."

On motion of Mr. Ricaud,

It was ordered, That Messrs. Ricaud and Bruce, be a committee to inform the members of the house of delegates, that His Excellency the Governor is in the Senate Chamber, ready to sign the laws, and to invite their attendance to witness that ceremony.

Accordingly, Mr Ricaud and Mr. Bruce retired; and after a time returned and reported that they had discharged the duty assigned them.

The honorable Speaker and members of the house of delegates appeared in the Senate Chamber—when His Excellency Governor Veazey signed the engrossed bills from No. 227 to No. 363 inclusive, (to which the great seal of the State had been previously fixed,) in the presence of the General Assembly, in conformity with the requirements of the constitution and the laws.

The Honorable Speaker and members of the house of delegates retired.

His Excellency the Governor also retired.

The Senate adjourned *sine die*.
