TITLES OF THE LAWS,
MADE AND PASSED AT
DECEMBER SESSION, 1837.

No. 1. An act to amend and make valid a certain instrument of writing therein mentioned.

2. An act to divorce Samuel Keplinger of the city of Baltimore, from his wife Mary Keplinger.

3. An act for the benefit of Mary Charles of Caroline county.

4. An additional supplement to the act entitled, an act to incorporate the Baltimore and Port Deposit Rail Road Company, passed at December session 1831, chapter 288.

5. An act to divorce Mary Ann Bayley of Dorchester county, from her husband Josiah Bayley, junior.

6. An act authorising the commissioners of Baltimore county, to provide a suitable apartment in some of the public buildings belonging to said county and city, for the accommodation of the trustees of the poor of said county.

7. An act to authorise John Milburn to bring into this State a negro slave for life.

8. An act to compensate Robert B. A. Tate, for extra services as clerk of the levy court of Queen Ann's county.

9. An act entitled, a supplement to an act to incorporate the citizens of Faneytown, in Carroll county, passed December session 1836, chapter 309.

10. An act to prevent the destruction of wild fowl in the head waters of the Chesapeake bay, in the several counties therein mentioned.

11. A further supplement to the act to incorporate the George's Creek Mining Company.
