We therefore require you or any three or two of you at some time and place as to you or any three or two you shall seem convenient you meet on the aforesaid Land called Gethsemane (you first having taken your Oaths on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God according to Act of Assembly in such case made and provided and there cause to come before you or any three or two of you all such evidences as shall be to you or any three or two of you nominated by the Complainant or depl. if any and that you or any three or two of you examine them upon their corporal Oaths to be by you or any three or two of you administered on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God in the presence of the Complainant or depl. if any touching the truth or Remembrance of their knowledge or any thing that may relate to the cause and that producing the several depositions into writing you send the same together with this our Commission under your or any three hands and seals to us to our County Court of Somerset with all convenient speed Within ss Robert King Esq. Chif Justice of our said Court the twenty ninth day of November Anno Domini One thousand seven hundred and thirty nine

And now to wit the third Tuesday of June being the fifteenth day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty two at a Court then held at Dividing Creek before his Lordships Justices in and for the County of Somerset came John Gale and Mathias Dashiell two of the gentlemen nominated in the above Commission and made return thereupon with the deposition thereto annexed in form following John Gale and Mathias Dashiell Gent. were qualified on the within Commission by me Geo. Dashiell We the subscribers being appointed Commissioners to examine Evidences in Relation to the bounds of a tract of Land called Gethsemane do hereby certify that we met on the said Land the 29th day of October 1741 and took the following depositions the person being first sworn by us given under our hands and seals this 11th day of June Anno Domini 1742

Mr James Train aged sixtyn four being sworn on the holy Evangelist of Almighty God saith that about ^{or fifteen} years ago he was riding along the road in company with Mr Nutter and bring in sight of a mulberry post this deponent asked what was the meaning of that post standing there and he told him that it was the bounds of three tracts of Land and doth not remember what the names of the Land was but he understood him that one of the tracts of Land was Gethsemane and one other of the tracts of Land lay to the Eastward and the other to the southward of the said post and that not long after that time the post was removed
