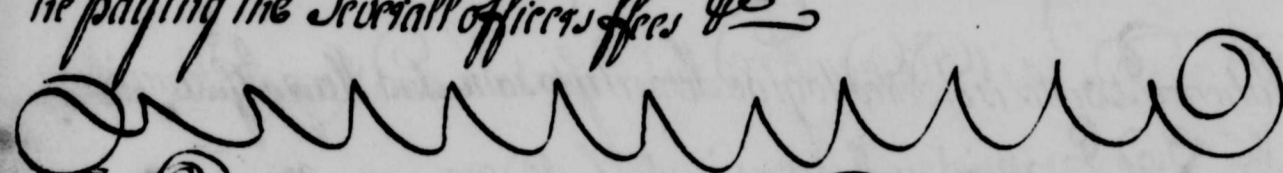

the Court here fully understood - It is Considered by the Court here that the said Benjamin Derison
pay unto his said Lordship the Right Honorable the Lord proprietary for his fine by the Court here
upon him Imposed for and by reason of the premises of &c whereof in form of &c he is Convict three pounds
Cur: money of Maryland and that the said Benjamin Derison be taken to satisfy his said Lordship of
the fine of &c Thereupon the said Benjamin Derison is discharged from the Information of &c
he paying the several officers fees &c

a certain person whose name is unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have
Carnal knowledge of her body and a bastard Child on the Body of her the same Patience then and there to
begett to the high displeasure of allmighty God to the evil Example of all others in such case offending
