Contrary to the peace of the said Lord Proprietor that now is his good rule and government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case made and provided & Whereupon the same Attorney of the said Lord Proprietor for the same Lord Proprietor by the advice of the Court herein the premises and that due process of Law in this part against the same Patience Bowles may be made to answer unto the same Lord Proprietor of and upon the premises & Thereupon command is to the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take the said Patience Bowles if she doth not answer & And now to wit at that same Court held for the County of dividing on this fifteenth day of June Anno Domini thousand seven hundred and forty two before the aforesaid Justices came the aforesaid Patience Bowles in her proper person according to a certain recognizance by her and her security in this part first acknowledged and had a hearing of the Information aforesaid with that she cannot deny but that she is guilty of the premises as in the Information aforesaid above upon her imposed in manner and form as by the Information aforesaid upon her supposed and makest witness that certain Edmond Knowles Junr is the begetter of the bastard child she stands Informed for and is willing to pay her fine for the fact aforesaid

Whereupon all and singular the premises being seen and by the Court hereof fully understood it is considered by the Court here that the aforesaid Patience Bowles pay unto his said Lordship the Right Honble the Lord Proprietor his fine by the Court hereupon her imposed for and by omission of the premises as a wherofit form as she is convicted thirty shillings curr<sup>t</sup> money of Maryland and that the said Patience Bowles be sent to satisfy his said Lordship of the fine aforesaid Whereupon the said Patience Bowles is ordered to give security to sue and have indemnified the Justices of the County of Somerset and their successors from all troubles burthen and charges that might accrue by means of the birth maintenance and bringing up of the child aforesaid

Thereupon the said Patience Bowles with George McLean of Somerset County planter present hereinbefore in his proper persons acknowledged themselves indebted unto his said Lordship the Right Honble the Lord Proprietor of the province of Maryland in forty pounds curr<sup>t</sup> money of their body goods or chattels lands or tenements severally to be made and levied to the use of the inhabitants of the County of Somerset for the time being if it happen that the said Patience Bowles and George McLean their heirs executors administrators or any of either of them do not from time to time and at all times hereafter acquit discharge and make himself as well the Justices of Somerset County Court for the time being as also the inhabitants of said County of and from all costs charges and burthen whatsoever for or by reason of the birth maintenance nourishing and bringing up of this child and of and from all other suits charges bounties or demands whatsoever touching or concerning of the same

Whereupon the said Patience Bowles is ordered to give good security for the payment of all debts or fees due or to be due to the
