His Lordships { Somerlyf Memorandum that at a session of the peace of his Lordship the Right Honourable the
Rose Roach - Lord propertary of the province of Maryland held at dividing Creek in Somerset County the third Tuesday -
of November witt the Eighteenth day of the same month Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty before his said
Lordships Justices the peace in the County aſt to keep & signed by the Oath of twelve Jurors being presented that Rose Roach
late of Somerset parish in the County aſt Spinster the tenth day January in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and thirty nine at the parish aſt in the County aſt and within the Jurisdiction of this Court did commit fornication
with a certain person to the Jurors aſt unknown and did permit the same unknown person then and there to have carnal
knowledge of her body and then and there to beget a bastard Child on the body of her the same Rose to the high displeasure of
of Almighty God to the evill Example of all others in such case offending contrary to the peace of the said Lord propertary
that nowis his good rule and government and against the form of the Act of Assembly in such case lately made and provided

Thereupon it is command the Sheriff of Somerset County that he should take Rose Roach if she should be found in
his baileywick and her should safe keep so that he might have her body before the Justices of his Lordships County Court of Somerset
to be held at dividing Creek in and for the County aſt the third Tuesday of March Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and forty to
answer unto his said Lordship of the Indictment aſt

And now to witt the third Tuesday of March being the seventeenth day of the same month
at about then held at dividing Creek in and for the County aforesaid before his Lordships Justices came the
aforesaid Rose Roach in her proper person and had a hearing of the Indictment aforesaid. and forasmuch as
it doth appear to the Court here that the aforesaid Rose Roach had committed fornication with a negro and by
such Inordinate copulation had permitted herself to be begott with Child aſt

Therefore it is considered by the Justices here that the Indictment aforesaid and all the pro-
ceeding thereon be quashed and altogether held for nought, and that the aſt Rose Roach of the Indictment aforesaid
be quiet. and ordered that his Lordships attorney exhibit an Information against the said Rose Roach Imme-
diately for such her Inordinate Copulation as aſt

Rose Roach late of Somerset Parish in the County aſt Spinster the tenth day of January in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred thirty and nine she being a Mulatto Woman who then was and still is the servant of a certain
Mary Fountain (untill she the said Rose shall attain the age of thirty and one years eight years of which term is yet
to come) within the Jurisdiction of this Court the said year aſt at the place aſt did commit Fornication with a certain
negro Tom the slave of a certain Nicholas Fountain and did permit the same negro slave to have carnal knowledge
of her body and then and there to beget a bastard Child on the body of her the same Rose to the high displeasure of
Almighty
