

Nov. 1788, AA Co. Court Proc. 1788, p. 104

Case first brought into April Ct. 1787

Charles Carroll

VS

Allen Quynn

Carroll leased to Quynn for 99 yrs. with yearly rent due Ap. 25 of £20 sur., on 25 May 1785, all that part of Lot 87 leased by Carroll, Sr. on 4 March 1772 to Charles Bryan

Quynn now in possession of land and owed Carroll £40 sur. by 25 Ap. 1787. Quynn paid £5 and still owes £ 35.

Carroll says he has damages to value of £60

Quynn gets case imparled until Nov. 1788, and finally says he can't deny charges

Court says Carroll should recover £ 35 and damages of (blank)
