Meeting of Quakers

Mother - Johanna Phillips, dau (1720 - ¹⁷⁸⁴ aft.)
widow of George Drew
dau. of Ed. James Phillips of BA (leg.)

had 1 1/2 sisters by John + George Drew
had ³ 1/2 brothers + sisters by Jacob's 1st marriage
NATHANIEL (1735 - 1775) is leg

had 4 Brothers (incl. JAMES GILES 1749/50 - aft. 1794)
+ 1 sister (sister + 1 brother dead by 1784)

Jacob was Quaker - large landowner BA (+ HA)
partner in Bush River Ironworks
+ Cumberland Forge

Capt. in 2nd Canadian (Hazen's) Regiment 1778, 1779

Major + aide de camp to Gen. ^{Daniel} Morgan 1779 - 1781

battle of Clouds" later served as Aide
de Camp. Gen. Wm. Smallwood to end of war
