with special warranty to refund purchase money in case of any
future lawful eviction

f. 707:

Whereas Mr. Charles Bryan has given bond dated 12 June 1769
for payment of £500, this certifies that I agree to charge no
interest on bond untill 1 Nov/ 1769, unless Mr. Samuel Chase,
who is now residing in house I have sold to Mr. Bryan, should
before quit possession of said House, in which case the
interest on bond is to commence from such time.
