

Senate Journal 1790

Samuel Chase

Resolved:

30 November 1790 - That £ 350 sterling be allowed to Samuel Chase, Esq. for extra ordinary services and expenses rendered and incurred by him as agent for the State, in prosecuting the states claim to the stock in the bank of England, to be deducted from the sum of £ 500 St. heretofore advanced by the state to sd Chase; provided he shall refund the sd sum of £ 350 St. if he shall hereafter draw a commission, to a larger amount, on the recovery of sd bank stock as agent for the State.
