Oct term, 1780

Altru Quym, assignee of Samuel Chase

vs  
William Whetcraft.

Case begun 1789

Whetcraft signed note to Chase on 24 Sept 1778  
to pay Chase \$442.10 by 1 Sept 1788

Aug, 1783 Chase signs note over to Quym

Whetcraft, if says he's pd. - John Caudall is his  
surety, + Thomas Jennings his attorney

Chase is Quym's attorney

Jury trial ordered. Whetcraft admits judgement  
to Quym for \$885 int. + 677 lbs int.

25 Oct 1780  
Quym agrees to forego penalty for payment of  
\$88.90 int. w/ interest from 24 Sept 1780 +  
costs.

Oct term, 1790

Samuel Clases Lessee  
vs  
Andrew Haraiden

Ejectment  
Not guilty + issue

Jury trial - defender did not  
appear to confess lease entry  
and issue.

Plaintiff in nonprossed and  
had judgment to recover agst  
the cardinal ejector

Plaintiff pd jury

Signed 20 Oct 1790

Gen'l Ct of West Shore G<sup>ts</sup> 4, 206-209  
May term 1789

Cornelius Durand  
vs  
John Dorsey

Case begun 30 Mar. 1787 in Gen'l Ct. (with 2 Dec. 1786)

John Dorsey "late of RSA, otherwise called J.D. of Baeto,  
town" on 22 Apr. 1784 "at Ste Croix"  
bound himself to Durand "sen'r of Ste Croix"  
for \$225 cur. to pay Durand \$112.10  
cur. before 1 Sept 1784

Dorsey gives bail Oct 1787 - surety is Wm Dorsey,  
attorney in Wm Hammond Dorsey.

Dorsey admits debt

Judgement 2 June 1789 for Durand for \$225 cur.  
+ 713 lbs tob.

"penalty to be released on payment of  
principal interest and costs. The defendant  
is released by the benefit of the Justment  
Act."



Gen'l Ct of West. Shore Judges TISH\*1, 716-718  
May term, 1781

John Dorsey

<sup>vs</sup>  
Christopher Burkhart of FR, distiller

Case begun July 1779

Dorsey says that on 2 Dec. 1778  
at FR Dorsey + Burkhart agreed that Burkhart would  
see Dorsey 200 gal. of whiskey delivered to Dorsey  
at Baeto-town by 1 March 1779 at rate of  
35 sh. of gal. Dorsey pd. £ 22.10 cur for the whiskey  
in part payment. Burkhart has + delivered  
whiskey

Case referred to Geo. Muddock + Christopher  
Edelin for award + judgement to be made there.
