Benj. Gabriels' father, owned only 1.50 a. of Barnalls Grove wch the son purchased from him in 1795. Gabriel purchased Orphan's Gift, Hill's Choice & Holidays' Choice accumulating between 650 & 700 a. wch he referred to, in the earlier 1800s, as the farm. The 1st documentation of the name "Marzetta" doesn't appear (so far) until 1816 when Gabriel dated a letter w/ that name

In Annapolis Jno Thos. Shaaf conveyed pt. of the Reuben Merriweather Lot on Cornhill St to Gabriel in 1800. (I can't find such a deed in the AA indices but it is mentioned in NH 10:206, Shaaf to Lucy Rummels)
