re: Duval - DuVal Pedigree

The enclosed 2 sheets on Duval - DuVal family of Maryland I copied yesterday from some my friend, Mrs J. Oliver Purvis (124 Charbrooke Rd Balto. 21212), had. She was Clover DuVal and is a lovely person aged 81, and looking 60. I have known her since childhood & her mother & my mother were girlhood friends. Yesterday she gave me a silver pitcher given to my mother on her marriage in 1912 who gave it to her mother on her 2nd marriage to Howard Young in 1935. It really is beautiful refinement sterling.

The pedigree is not that impressive at first glance but on study you will find them well connected: Bushiers, (Brashears, Brasuers), Griffiths, Tyfers, Price (of Brice House, Annapolis), McClelland, etc. And Gabriel Duval of "Marietta" P.G. Co. was a U.S. Supreme Court Justice under Madison. I noted that he co-owned the Seven Mountains tract of Johnson Island in 1780 with my 4th gr. Grand father, Thomas Hyde of Annapolis.

All this started when I saw, last Sat. at Univ. Hosp. Antique Show in Fidelity, a large miniature on ivory of Mrs Edmund Brice DuVal (Augusta McClelland). The Md. Historical Soc. wants it. I told Clover about it which prompted her to give me the silver pitcher as well as handing me the brief pedigree.

I gave MHS a copy of the pedigree since it pertained to the miniature. And as I was in Annapolis, to see epitherologist, today decided to drop a copy off for Hall of Records. It was between 12 & 1 PM and when I spoke to Don Williams in the lobby & asked him to accept the pedigree for you he said he was on his lunch break. The state policewoman said she could not receive it for Hall of Records. Williams did go so far as to say I could leave it on receptionist's desk with a note that it was for you. I told him I thought this was bureaucracy at its worst & left. So now I am mailing it to you.

Please do not bother to thank me, or Williams.
