I. Ogle's Petition: (submitted 13 Jan 1791)

Robert Bryce, now dec. was indebted to Ogle for £52..2..8. On 12 June 1771, Robt. mortgaged to Ogle 1/2 lot 70 unless money paid by 12 Dec. 1771. (McW note: see IB#3 f. 109) Ogle says Robert never paid anything and then died. Now Ogle can not sell land while it is liable to redemption of John. Asks Ct. to settle problem -ie. make John pay or clear Ogle's title.

II. Feb. Ct. 1792 - Gabriel Duvall appears to act as guardian for John.

John says his father did mortgage lot, but doesn't know if anything paid on it. Says his father died about 20 years ago. Also that Ogle started ejectment proceedings against Frances and recovered judgement for possession of house and lot in said bill & see March 1786.) and hath had possession thereof from some time in said year. John says Ogle has " Tenanted the premises, and received rent from same" John says Ogle can foreclose if he gives John credit for a just allowance for the use of mortgaged premises since his possession of same.

III. Decision: 10 April 1792

John will be 21 in 6 months. John to pay Ogle before October 10, 1792, £166..2..2 cur. being principal and interest to the 1st of August 1786 when Ogle got possession. If John pays then Ogle shall give release. But, if John defaults, then title goes clear to Ogle.

McW. note: Index to Deeds, Vol. B 1653-1839, for period 1792-1795 shows no release to John, or mention of property.

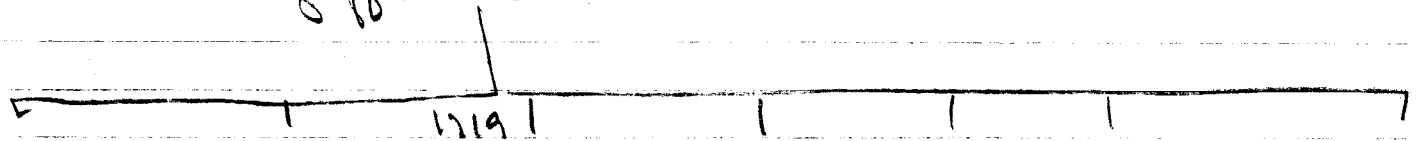

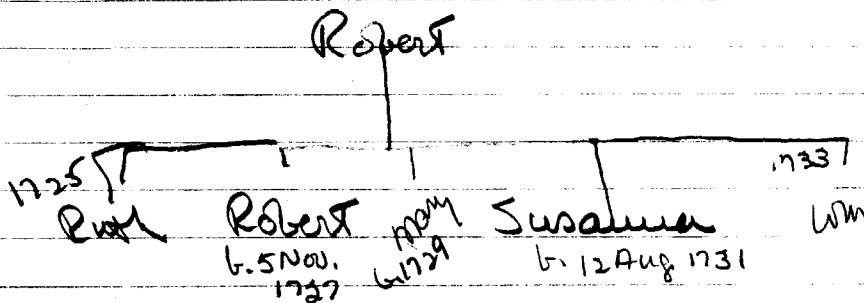
