**Ex-Gov. Bowie to Sell His Racers
and Lead a Country Life.**

EX-JUDGE HILL'S SUDDEN DEATH.

**Ex-Gov. Lloyd a Candidate for Congress
—The Factional Fight Goes Steadily
On—Annual Tournament of the Prince
George's Rifles—Cattle Disease.**

MARLBORO', MD., Aug. 24.—In the early fall ex-Governor Bowie will dispose of his stables and lead a country life. He has been spending much of his time at Saratoga during the present summer, but is expected home today. Mr. Bowie has owned some very valuable and noted horses, among them Belle d'Or, Vosburg, Alarm Bell, Blackwood, Mirthwood, Twilight colt, Catamaran, Tennessean, Lordlike, Fairy, Crikmore, Compensation, Belle, Oriole, Dellemeade, Catesby, Dickens and Legatee. His horses now at Saratoga will not return to Fair View, the Prince George's county residence of Mr. Bowie, but will remain in New York, perhaps at Bruce's Tattersalls, until sold.
