

# McKeldin Wins Approval For Indian Position

Washington, Jan. 14 — Former Governor Theodore R. McKeldin's appointment to the Federal Indian Claims Commission won approval today from the Senate Committee on Interior and Insular Affairs.

The committee recommendation, which generally precedes a smooth confirmation by the full Senate, came after a hearing this morning at which both Maryland senators testified in support.

Mr. McKeldin has been serving as a commissioner for about five weeks under a recess appointment by President Johnson.
