Former State Senator David G. McIntosh, Jr., died at his home, 'Dumbarton', on the York Road, south of Towson, late yesterday afternoon following a month's illness.

He was elected a member of the House of Delegates in 1913 and in 1919 was elected State Senator, serving four terms, two of which he was President of the Senate. In 1934 he was a Democratic candidate for the Governorship, but withdrew to give the late Governor Albert C. Ritchie a clear field.

No funeral arrangements had been made up until the time The Jeffersonian went to press.
