Buried In National Cemetery.

John Anderson, colored, a veteran of the Civil War, and a member of the colored Post G. A. E., who died on Saturday at the Crownsville Hospital for the Colored Insane of the State, was buried on Monday afternoon in the National Cemetery, West street.

Anderson was a former employee of the Naval Academy. Some years ago the old colored man suffered from frostbite, and had no one to care for him. His suffering is said to have weakened his mentality.

His funeral was attended by the remaining members of Sheridan Post, G. A. R., of this city, of whom there are but few remaining.
