# **Bay Problems Occupy Mathias After 5-Day Trip**

ANNAPOLIS, June 26 (AP) —Sen. Charles McC. Mathias returned today after a five-day tour of Chesapeake Bay and said that rapid action is needed to alleviate the problems of the huge waterway.

"We have room to run, but not very much," the Maryland Republican said as he stepped onto the Annapolis city dock. "We know that unless we move very rapidly, we're not going to get on top of the problem."

Mathias spent five days inspecting the bay, traveling 375 miles by water, 100 by land and 100 by air.

"Something really has to happen," he said, suggesting that a multi-state and federal compact could be one method of launching a concerted attack on pollution.
