Effects and purposes Province. ut supra.

20th July 1644.

Edward Parker being to goe to Sea made his Will (Viz^t) -
that he gave one half of all he hath to Cusly Lowger, and one
Tobacco to the Chappell the Residue to Elisabeth Spears.

Francis Ansell aged 22th years old or thereabouts made oath that he
was present when Leonard Calvert Esq. made his Will in his last sick-
ness in manner following by word of mouth Viz^t that he did
nominate Mrs Margaret Brent his sole Executrix.
Ed. Mrs Mary Brent deposes the same, and further she deposes that
that he did desire that his Executrix should give the first Marslett,
that shall fall within this year (and if none fall within this year
then the first Marslett that shall hereafter fall) unto M^r Thom-
as Piggott of Virginia -

June 19th This Day came Margaret Brent Gov. and desired
the Testimony of the Gov. M^r Thomas Green concerning
the last will and Testam^t of the late Govern^r Leonard Calvert Esq. &
the said Gov. did authorize Giles Brent Esq. one of his Judges
Councill to administer an oath unto him the said Governour
concerning the fore said business. -

The said Gov. Thomas Green Esq. answered upon oath, concerning
the last will and Testam^t of Leo. Calvert Esq. viz^t that he the
said Leo. Calvert dying upon his death bed some 6. hours before
his death being in perfect memory, directing his Speech to
M^r Margaret Brent said in presence of him the said M^r Green,
and some of us, I make you my sole Executrix, take all and pay
all. after which words he the said Leo. Calvert desired Every one to
depart the room and was some space in private conference wth
M^r Margaret Brent Esq. afterwards the P^r M^r Green coming
into the room again, he heard the said M^r Leo. Calvert appoint
certain Legacies in manner following. (Viz^t) Give my wearing
Coaths to James & Lindsey and Richard Wilkin my servants spe-
cifying his Coath Suit to Richard Wilkin and his Black Suit to
James.
