## Governor Nice and Family Occupying Executive Mansion

Governor Harry W. Nice and family, with members of their family, arrived at the Executive Mansion at 10:50 A. M. today, taking up their residence there shortly before the inaugural ceremonies. The arrival of the new chief executive and his family, for a stay of at least four years, interested the people quite as much as the usual rites attending Governor's inauguration.

This is the first time that the mansion has had an official hostess since the death of Governor Ritchie's mother several years ago, the crowd was eager to get a glimpse of Maryland's new first lady.

Mrs. Nice, who is dignified and graceful in appearance and manner, was gowned in black. She wore a black velvet gown, the waist of which was of marquisette, applied with velvet rings, and a black coat, with black hat and accessories.

Governor Nice's sister, Miss May Nice, an assistant superintendent of the Union Memorial Hospital, rode in the automobile with her brother and his family. Governor and Mrs. Nice have one son, Mr. Harry Nice, who will make his home at the Executive Mansion with his parents.

Governor and Mrs. Nice do not intend to do any extensive entertaining until the Governor's home has been repaired, and a number of contemplated improvements have been completed.
